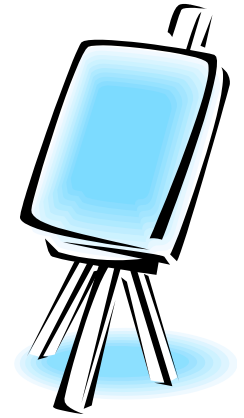
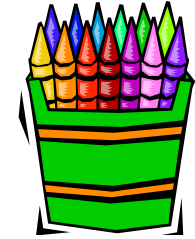


# ***MAKING ART***
